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RETRACT ARTICLE: SOCIAL COGNITION INTERVENTIONS FOR ADOLESCENTS WITH AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER. A SYSTEMATIC REVIEW. (GARCÍA-VÁZQUEZ ET AL.)

Dear readers and authors of the article

With the commitment to maintain the highest levels of quality, the editorial committee has decided to retract the article.

After an exhaustive review we have identified several similarities with another article published in 2020.

The authors explain their review has two objectives, on the one hand to examine and synthesize interventions based on social cognition for adolescents with ASD and on the other to provide data on their properties, in which it differs from Tseng's review.

Although the search strategy and inclusion and exclusion criteria differ from the review, as the authors use the modified version of the Newcastle-Ottawa Scale (NOS) to analyze

the quantitative articles and the Critical Appraisals Skills Program checklist for the qualitative ones, which is probably one of the reasons the review may not include a greater number of new studies.

Although the review includes information about the interventions carried out on its properties. As well as more sociodemographic information about the included studies. Regarding the PRISMA diagram as well as the table that includes the main characteristics of the studies is original and collect data and information that are not included in Tseng's review (country, N, age range, duration of the study). intervention, main results...).

After an exhaustive review, we consider that the article published in our journal does not meet the required originality criteria, so we have considered that the most appropriate option is to retract the article, this means that it will be removed from the online version and in any other type of publication

We regret the inconvenience that this decision may have caused to the authors and readers, but this decision has been made with the aim of preserving the scientific quality of the journal.
